Brassall State School will receive



## This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of **Prep students** reaching PM Benchmark Reading Level 5 to 95%.
- **Year 3 NAPLAN:** Increase the percentage of students reaching the 'National Minimum Standard' in Reading to 93%.
- **Year 3 NAPLAN:** Increase the percentage of students reaching the 'Upper Two Bands' in Reading to 34%.
- **Year 3 NAPLAN:** 100% of **Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students** reaching the 'National Minimum Standard' in Reading.
- **Year 5 NAPLAN:** Increase the percentage of students reaching the 'National Minimum Standard' in Reading to 92%.
- **Year 5 NAPLAN:** Increase the percentage of students reaching the 'Upper Two Bands' in Reading to 27%.
- Build capability of all staff to deliver engaging, differentiated, high impact teaching and learning experiences.

## Our initiatives include

- Developing a rich culture of observation and feedback through continual coaching of staff in research based pedagogical practices focussed on the teaching of Reading.
- Establishing Professional Learning Communities of teachers, specialist staff and school leaders who will use a Case Management and Collaborative Data Inquiry to enhance teaching practices and student outcomes with a focus on Reading.
- Enhancing differentiated and inclusive teaching practices so that the learning of all students is effectively supported.
- Employ a full-time Speech Language Therapist to implement early intervention and speech programs to increase the vocabulary of students primarily in Prep and Year 1.
- Employ additional Teacher aide time to support reading intervention programs in Years 2, 3, 4 and 5 and speech language intervention programs for students in Prep and Year 1.
- Focus professional learning for teaching staff on Reading, Australian Curriculum: English and Age Appropriate Pedagogies.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

Employing a full-time Pedagogy Coach to support the consistent teaching of Reading across the school	\$126 000
Employing a full-time Head of Curriculum – Student Services to focus on resourcing, engagement and attendance	\$126 000
Employing a full-time Speech Language Therapist	\$55, 000
Releasing teachers to implement Early Start in Prep (Semesters 1&2) and Year 1 (Semester 2)	\$20 680
Employing additional teacher aides to support Speech Language development and Literacy intervention	\$126 000
